This insidious and far-reaching innovation was essayed by the promulgation under s. 127 of the Bankruptcy Act, 1883, of the following rule: (59) If the Court shall. . . be of opinion that it would be desirable that a person (other than the person before whom the examination is taken) should be appointed to take down the evidence. . . . in Shorthand or otherwise, it shall be competent for the Court to make such appointment; and every person so appointed shall be paid a sum not exceeding 3s. 6d. per hour or part of an hour, and, where the Court appoints a Shorthand Writer, a sum not exceeding 4d....
