This action by the Department helped to get these necessary regulations moving. With the release of Appendix A, all companies, not just the initial 100, are filling out the Top-Screen. The results of the Top-Screen determine whether a facility will be regulated under CFATS. These facilities that have relatively small amounts of chemicals, or otherwise pose low risks, will not be regulated. If the facility is determined to have a sufficient amount of a chemical of concern, however, it will be regulated. Under the regulation, the next step is for a facility to complete a Security Vulnerability Assessment and a Site Security Plan, which must be approved by the Department and implemented by the facility. We are fortunate to have before us today representatives from the Department and a regulated company to provide us with insight into the...
